- [30-amp EV-specific adapter](#)

Nice to have:

- [50-amp extension cord](#)
- [CHAdeMO adapter](#)
- [Squeegee and windshield cleaning spray](#)
- [Trash bags](#)
- [Umbrella](#)

Remember:

- Download the charging network apps you'll need ahead of time.
- Check weather conditions before you leave; slow down if you have head winds.
- Check the status of a charger on PlugShare.
- Don't leave your car charging once it's fully charged.
- Pull into chargers appropriately, so you don't block other chargers.
- It's easier to start slow and speed up if you're getting good battery consumption.
